



Born in Denizli in 1969, Dr. Selami Kılıç completed his primary and secondary education in Ankara, followed by his graduation in 1993 from Quaid-e-Azam Medical College on a state scholarship.

Serving at numerous provincial organizations of the Ministry of Health over the course of 19 years in various roles such as physician at PHC center, physician in charge, physician at 112 emergency health station, emergency physician at hospital, head of health group, deputy provincial director of health, and deputy director of public health, Dr. Kılıç carried his knowledge and experience to the central organization of the Ministry of Health in 2012.

Assuming the role of the Head of the Department of International Health Policies at the General Directorate for European Union and Foreign Affairs in 2012, Dr. Kılıç has served as the Director-General for European Union and Foreign Affairs, acting as agent from 2017 to 2021 and as principle since 2021.

During his tenure, he took an active part in more than 200 international organizations and representation events attended by senior government officials, including heads of state, prime ministers, and ministers.

In addition to his position as the Director-General for EU and Foreign Affairs at the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Türkiye, Mr. Kılıç has assumed the role of Chairperson of the Board of Directors of the International Health Services Incorporation on June 22, 2022.
